# Submit Now For The Lieutenant Govenor's Award for Literary Excellence

Entry deadline: January 31, 2017

Although the deadline has passed for some of the BC Book Prizes, there is still the opportunity to submit entries for the Lieutenant Governor's Award for Literary Excellence.

Publishers and members of the writing and publishing community are invited to submit nominations. The next deadline for nominations is Tuesday, January 31, 2017. There is no fee to submit a nomination.

For the Lieutenant Governor's Award for Literary Excellence a jury of three industry professionals review all of the nominations received and collectively select a recipient whom they recommend to the Lieutenant Governor for final approval. The recipient of the Lieutenant Governor's Award for Literary Excellence is announced prior to the Gala, which is held annually in the spring (late April, early May). # **Top 6 Reasons Why Indie Writers Making Gains In eBook Market**

Here are some of the top reasons that self-published indie writers are set to capture a large percentage of the e-book market in next decade:

- 1. Independent bookstores are growing rarer
- 2. Successful indie writers are mentoring a whole new generation of self-published and e-book writers
- 3. There is an increasing distance forming between writers and publishers, with authors demanding more say in book design and marketing
- 4. The stigma of being self-published is fast disappearing
- 5. Authors no longer have to take no for an answer from publishers, they can prove their own worth in a free marketplace.
- 6. Self-publishing is fun and allows writers to express other sides of their creativity, such as their graphic design talents.

## **Crafting Press Releases That Pack a Punch**

For Immediate Release: these words demand to be followed by something exciting, newsworthy--something that really delivers on the sentence's trumpet- blast opener.

Indie writers are often on their own when it comes to promoting their new books. Without professional publishers and a team of seasoned marketing staff behind them, promoting their work, it is essential that they understand how to write engaging press releases that will really have impact.

In order for your press release to catch the eye of a reader, news editor or journalist, it needs to have an angle - something newsworthy that makes it stand out from the crowd by giving readers a story they can identify with and care about. You could include details on how you got started writing, what incidents generated your story, or include interesting personal details, such as recently receiving an award. Always write about yourself in the third person and be sure to include any positive reviews and quotes you may have received from well-respected authors.

Apart from getting your name in the local paper and giving your book the publicity essential to fuelling book sales, a well-crafted press release posted online can also do wonders for your author website or blog if you word it right. Don't forget to include keywords and links that, when picked up by Google News and other sites, will ultimately direct readers back to your page, resulting in more traffic and thereby increasing your rankings.

Traditionally, a press release should end with an author bio and then a final paragraph summarizing your contact details including email and telephone numbers. There are lots of sample press releases and blogs to help you hone your skills at press-release writing, so although it may at times feel that way, the indie writer is never truly on his/her own.
